Green Road

Quote for brambles removal at Green Road allotment site. Quote accepted. Work to be done in August - after the bird nesting season.

Quote for removal of asbestos. Quote accepted, we are to provide a skip for the wood etc from the shed.

The main stopcock/water valve has ceased up – clerk to report to Anglian Water. Hodney Road

Plumber has looked and is to provide a quote to reinstate the water supply to the allotments – new main valve/meter/stop cock on site and half standpipes.

Will need to scrape back and cut down the vegetation 2m strip.

69) Eye Primary School

No agreement as yet as to where the new mobile classrooms are to be sited – needed for the new term in September.

The Children's Centre is being transferred to the school.

70) Leeds Hall, Recreation Ground and Amenities

Pavilion – Quotation for CCTV. Stand-alone system. Will record and will need Wi-Fi. Cameras to cover the Pavilion and Recreation Ground. Agreed to go ahead.

Plumber has repaired the valve and the Legionella contractors will now come and drain down and disinfect the system ready for full opening hopefully on 19th July. Grass is growing rapidly.
