

**Minutes of a Meeting of Eye Parish Council held
in the Leeds Hall, High Street, Eye on Thursday 16th June 2022 at
7.00pm.**

Consultation with the public until 7.10pm – 3 present

Mr McKean told the meeting that there is concern with anti-social behaviour at the Open Space, skate-park, on the park, the car park and the Youth Shelter. Broken bottles etc. Has been happening for the last 4 months, it did go quieter but has increased again. Licenced Officers have visited the local shops to advise on the sale of alcohol. Incidents have been reported – bottles deliberately smashed on the footpath and on the grass. Bags of drugs been seen being dealt in the pond area. Broken glass found on Saturday on the car park and at the Youth Shelter.

Gas canisters have also been strewn around the area.

PC Cullimore told the meeting that the police had been made aware of the issues of ASB. Unfortunately it is a problem citywide. The police will patrol as often as they can and urge that all incidents are reported.

Tony Clements reported that the ex- Autistic commercial property at 100 High Street has been vacant for a while and there are 3 large bins on the edge of the property which haven't been emptied. Coun Simons will arrange for these to be emptied. It is not known what the future plans are for the property.
