Councillors aware that the Admission Team have been told that Eye Primary School has stated it cannot take more than 60 new starter children in September. It is the only school in the area that is being considered for development. Councillor Simos visited the school today.

The councillors were disappointed that the Parish Council decline to assist with funding for the trim trail. The Parish Council don't believe it is that much used and think the money can be better spent on amenities in other area of the village.

The Parish Council were disappointed that the plans for the storage area near Aldi had been approved – problems with traffic in that area already. Highways England and the RHA involved.

Froglife are continuing their work at the Nature Reserve and are working with the Archaeologists and not operating in certain areas.

Still concerns with 47 The Crescent that work is not as per the planning permissions – Coun Simons will look at.
